




## AGM & CONFERENCE 2017 GLASGOW

14th & 15th MARCH 2017







- The Scottish Licensed Trade Association's 137<sup>th</sup> Annual General meeting will take place on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2017 in the Malmaison Hotel, 278 West George Street, Glasgow G2 4LL, during the Scottish Tourism Week Event running from the 15th 23rd March 2017. A special two night package (14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of March) for SLTA members attending the AGM is available.
- The week-long event incorporates the Scottish Tourism Alliance Signature Conference which this year is entitled "Tourism: The Future Beyond 2020'. The conference is all about looking ahead at everything in the political, economic, consumer and environmental worlds that will impact and affect Scotland's global competitiveness and perception as a destination of choice.
- The Scottish Thistle Awards will add a glittering celebratory element to Scottish Tourism Week, taking place this year on Thursday
  16th March at the EICC, in Edinburgh.
- The STW 2017 Parliamentary Reception, co-sponsored by The Caravan Club and VisitScotland, will be held at the Scottish
  Parliament on 22nd March, and the final Scottish Tourism Week Signature event will see the Scotland Food & Drink AGM and

All trains go direct to Central Station.


### From the East and North
